Recommendations for Manifesto

Ministry of Home Affairs (MoHA)

1. Elections and Democracy

- a. Voting rights will be granted to Nepalis working abroad and those living outside their home districts.
- b. A "No Vote" option will be included on the ballot to allow voters to reject all candidates.
- c. Polling stations will be secured primarily by the Nepal Police to ensure a fearless environment for voters.
- d. The proportional representation system will be reviewed to ensure seats go to marginalized groups and not family members of leaders.

2. Police Reform and Security

- a. Police promotions will be based on a Key Performance Indicator system where officers are rewarded for reducing crime and building trust.
- b. The 30-year service limit for police officers will be removed to retain experienced and capable leaders.
- c. Harassment of citizens/overpolicing for minor issues like walking at night will be stopped immediately.
- d. A clear chain of command will be established (Police → APF → Army) where the Army is deployed only as a last resort during protests.
- e. Strict training on emotional control will be provided to security forces to prevent violence during crowd management.

3. Transparency and Corruption Control

- a. All government tenders and contracts will be recorded on an immutable Blockchain ledger to prevent data tampering.
- b. Artificial Intelligence agents will be used to automatically audit contracts and flag costs that are higher than market rates.
- c. Government reports will be required to show actual outcomes and results rather than just listing expenses.
- d. A public transparency portal will be launched to show raw data (non-sensitive only) on security deployments and budget spending.

4. National Safety and Disaster Management

- a. Cargo trucks at the border will be physically inspected to stop the smuggling of drugs.
- b. A specialized unit will be created within the Ministry to treat drug trafficking as a serious national security threat.
- c. A single emergency number will be established to connect citizens to Police, Ambulance, and Fire services instantly.
- d. Police forces will be deployed to vulnerable highways before heavy rains start to prevent accidents and save lives.

5. Governance and Technology

- a. Citizenship, License, and Voter IDs will be merged into one single National ID card.
- b. The Nagarik App will be upgraded to allow citizens to handle banking, taxes, and certificates without paperwork.
- c. All national data regarding banking and citizens will be stored on servers inside Nepal.
- d. Public administrative centers like Singha Durbar will be opened to the general public.

6. Citizenship and Residency

- a. Permanent Residency will be offered to foreign investors to encourage business without selling Nepali citizenship.
- b. Dual Residency will be allowed for Nepalis living abroad to help them bring skills and capital back to the country.
- c. A Migration Control Department will be formed to identify and remove foreign nationals staying illegally.
